CURRENT PROJECTS

- 2016-17 *Fire & Ice* : Two expeditions involving *Crossing the Simpson*, 520 km of the world's largest parallel sand dune desert and Australia's driest land; in preparation for *The Last Great March*—a two-men 800km unsupported ski to the North Pole from Ward Hunt Island in Northern Canada and what is considered the toughest expedition on the planet to support climate research and incite action on climate change. (Training in the Arctic will begin in April 2016). Both without support and filmed for a six parts Red Bull-produced mini series.
- 2017 Start editing of *The Antarctica Legacy Crossing* a feature documentary chronicling the record setting 4,000 km crossing of the Antarctica Continent on the centenary of the South Pole
- 2018 Re-publishing of Sebastian's best selling title *Antarctica: The Global Warning* with updated texts and new images with teNeues Publishing.
- 2018 Gates of the Luxembourg, in Paris. A large outdoor exhibit titled *From Pole to Pole –The Call of the Ice* commissioned by the French Senate, featuring 80 large-scale images. The show's four months duration is visited by up to 3.5 million people.
- 2019 Development of *Ice: The 5th Element*©: a traveling "edutainment" exhibition on climate change. Housed in an itinerant building made to emulate an iceberg, the show is an interactive, immersive platform on everything to do with ice, from its beauty to its geopolitical relevance. An iceberg comes to your town to tell its story. This global event is designed to travel the G20 cities over the next 10 years.
